



# Ambassador's Fellowship Missions Trip to Haiti February 22-29, 2020

## Ministry Goals:

1. To continue the ministry of discipleship at the Eternal Hope of Haiti orphanages through daily devotions, fellowship, service and evangelism in the prison, and celebration with children, youth, and young adults.
2. To expose the missions team to ministry from a long-term missions perspective.
3. To prepare those called from Haiti to be sent as full-time missionaries to unreached nations

## Cost: \*\*\$1750 per person

Includes airfare from Washington, DC to Cap Haitian, Haiti; lodging; meals; ground transportation; and contributions to cover expenses associated with ministry expenses.

\*\*The costs may be higher depending on the departure location and baggage fees.

### *Required Steps:*

2. Pay the required deposit to reserve your space.
3. Complete, notarize, and submit your release form to Ambassador's Fellowship.
4. Complete, sign, and submit the "Under Age 18" form, if applicable.
5. Have a valid passport.



### *Recommended:*

1. Get malaria prophylaxis, a malaria prevention medication, prescribed by your doctor to take for your upcoming trip to Haiti.
2. Ensure you are up-to-date on all of your immunizations, such as influenza (flu), pneumonia (if applicable), shingles (if you are age 50+), and tetanus/t-dap,
3. Consider getting the Hepatitis A and B vaccine series, and typhoid vaccine.
